There were so many volunteers that came forward that my job as BBQ Chair was fun and exciting. So fun and exciting that I am chairing it again this year. We are looking for a co-chair that can take the job for 2008. If one of you is able to "learn the ropes" this year, you will find the job fun and fulfilling.

My concern is that we have a good number of projects underway, as well as more projects in the planning stage. We continue to need volunteers to give their time to the Nutriosos Community Association. Right now, I understand that most of you haven't returned to your summer homes in Nutriosos. A few diligent members are being physically strained with the building of the canopy over the basketball court. Needless to say, we really need new recruits to help with the concrete pour, placing the steel posts, putting up the trusses, etc. We are looking for members who can take leadership over maintaining the grounds, painting, and cleanup. There are clean new bathrooms, a temporary heating system, and a beginning of an updated kitchen. ### **\$ Treasury Notes \$**

The NCA treasury continues to do well. In December, the County approved the expenditures for the canopy over the basketball court, and that project is well under way. At the end of March, our cash in the bank was \$12,720.00 including the BBQ CD (\$5,000) that was put aside last fall. In April, we purchased a new refrigerator and a used dough machine, at a cost of \$3300, which will be split with the County.

The budget for 2007-2008 is still a works in progress, but will be ready to be voted on at the next annual meeting in August, after the BBQ. As always, your input is valued and needed, and can be given at our monthly board meetings.

Our fund raisers continue to do well, with the shirts, hats, cookbooks, note cards and license plates available at Boggy Creek in Springerville, bringing in small but appreciated revenue for the Treasury.
